Our research team at New York Orthopedics, in collaboration with the Nicholas Institute of Sports Medicine and Athletic Trauma is enrolling patients scheduled for total knee replacement surgery in a study investigating whether ambulatory or inpatient care results in better outcomes.

Where: virtual surgical outcome system (SOS) portal

Why: to help us collect patient reported outcomes

To be included in the study you need to: be scheduled for total knee replacement; have access to a computer and the internet; agree to complete pre-surgery, and post-surgery online surveys at various time points

If interested you will: be enrolled in the SOS portal presurgery; once you activate your SOS account, complete the questionnaires that are emailed to you pre-surgery, 2, and 6 weeks, 3, and 6 months, 1, and 2 years post-surgery
